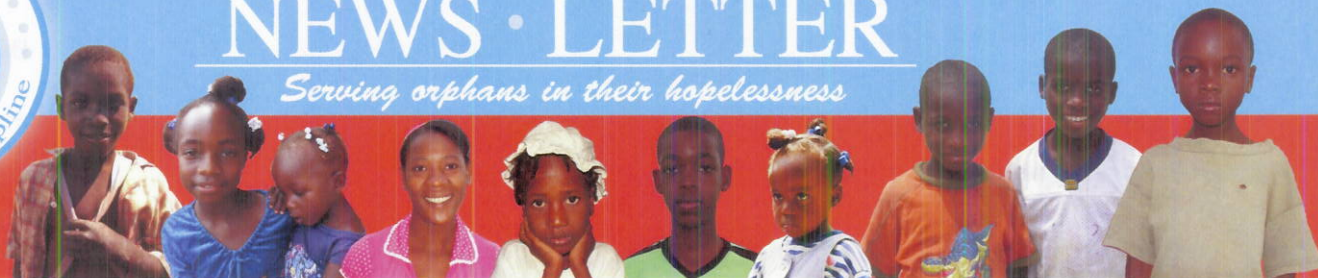

The orphans, however, remain the number one priority for OIH and the building projects only complete the entire package of caring for these children, as well as the community.



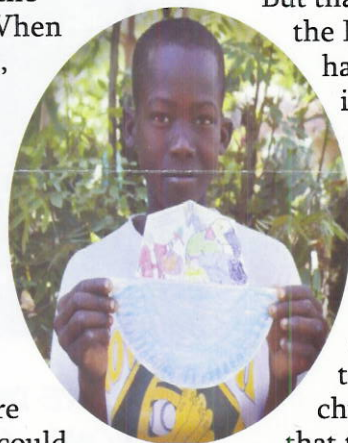
In 2003, our initial focus of OIH was to evangelize the area of Bombardopolis, Haiti. When we first arrived in Haiti, though, we realized that there were so many children abandoned, for various reasons, who needed us if they were to survive. And by taking care of these little ones, we have been able to evangelize through the children, exemplifying Christ's love.

As God placed each child before us, many more than we felt we could care for, the community watched to see what our "faith" could do.

The community has witnessed OIH taking in 60 orphans, quite a few more than the six we started with. They have watched in amazement

as plans came together for a warehouse, missionary home, a well, and now a church. Their very own church!

All of these things were part of the overall package for the mission facility, but we did not know in what order God wanted us to proceed. Should we start rebuilding an orphanage? School? Clinic? And that is the interesting part. Quite possibly, if OIH had decided to build things in the order they felt they should be built to best meet the needs of the children, it would have been a new orphanage, school, medical facility, etc.



But that is not the way the Lord has led. He has placed it on individual's hearts to donate for certain projects, i.e. medical, food, well project, church. Funds came into the office specifically to begin the OIH church, and so it is that the New Jerusalem

Seventh-day Adventist Church in Bombardopolis, Haiti, was begun. As you can see, we have a lot of money to raise yet, but we have faith that this, indeed, is what the Lord wanted to happen next at



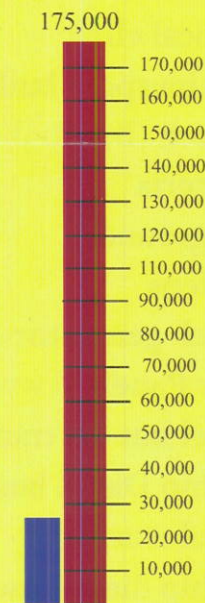
the OIH facility.
