With Christ as our example, OIH preaches the gospel, provides medical care for the sick and feeds orphans and widows in the poorest part of rural Haiti. It is the calling of Orphans International Helpline to bring hope spiritually and help physically to these people, especially to the orphans and widows. Showing compassion and sympathy for them make the lessons of Jesus' love come alive.

However, in order for our missionaries to spread the gospel message in Haiti, we need you to spread the message to your friends and family and church family here at home about the work that is being done in Haiti to bring souls to Jesus, and we need their support!

The orphans are as reliant upon OIH for their sustenance as your own children are on you for their needs. We are their collective parents. We are responsible for their spiritual training and growth



and for their physical well being.

The joy of receiving a note or a photo from a sponsor is evidenced by a smile that rapidly spreads across a face, laughter and giggles. But when the children know that missionaries are coming from OIH, their anticipation and joy is immeasurable.

As we teach these children, the Holy Spirit works on their hearts. With every visit, we see them becoming more and more open to receiving God's message. They are the future of Haiti. If we train these children, they will go to their friends and relatives in the surrounding villages and speak of God's grace and love.

Watching the children's excited anticipation of missionaries arrival, it is easy to make the comparison with how God's people will feel when He comes to take His people home. OIH is thrilled knowing that God is using us to increase that number.

## In faith we have accepted a 40' container of food from **Feed My Starving Children**

*They provide free food to ministries who are providing food to starving people in the world.*

OIH has one more month to raise the remaining \$6,000 for shipping and customs costs for a 40' container that is to be shipped to Haiti in November. We have given the fund raising to the Lord. Partnering with **Feed My Starving Children** was an answer to our prayers, as providing nutritional meals has always been a struggle and it has become even more of one since January 2010.

For those of you who have not been able to go to Haiti on a mission trip, I can only tell you from experience that anything on your plate that is not eaten and gets scraped off into the garbage disposal here at home would be devoured without a second thought by a Haitian if it was offered to him/her. None of them, except for the wealthy, have enough to eat daily. Being able to send this 40' container would be manna from heaven.

## Feed My Starving Children - Update

In November, the prayer of OIH is to be able to receive 270,864 meals (that is 38 pallets of food weighing 41,652 pounds!) from **Feed My Starving Children**. **WHILE THE FOOD IS FREE, SHIPPING IS NOT.** The quotes we have received to date average \$10,000 per shipment to get the food to our facility from the FMSC location in Minneapolis. Based on the amount of children we feed daily in our orphanage, at school and through our community food distribution program, we are scheduled to receive a 40' container of food every four months. That amounts to \$40,000 annually for the feeding program. The partnership with FMSC has been an answer to our prayers. Providing food is a very important part of the OIH community evangelism outreach in Bombardopolis.

Please prayerfully consider making a commitment to financially support this program. Encourage your church, Sabbath School class, school, work place, etc., to make it their special mission project to provide food to an area of Haiti that receives no humanitarian aid apart from what OIH provides.
